

FOGGY DEW

Re-choreographed 2009, replacing a previous dance from 1992 or 1993. Music by Kim Robertson, from Wind Shadows Vol.2. NB as of mid-2009, iTunes had the music, but the tracks on the album were mislabelled. The tunes Butterfly Jig and Foggy Dew constitute one track. I use a lengthened recording as the original is rather short.

Arms; V, though it might work in close-hold or basketweave with a confident group. Rhythm 4/4, with each step 1 beat. The dance fits the musical phrases most of the way through, but towards the end there is a change and the dance sequence becomes one bar out from the music phrase. Start on the first main beat after the first two short notes.

1. \circlearrowright moving diagonally forward to the right R, in place L, R (two gentle steps, like a cat padding), moving diagonally backwards to the right L; R, in place L, R (as before), moving diagonally forward to the right L. This makes a zigzag pattern with a flat top and bottom, consisting of a four-step motif starting forwards to the right, and then the same motif starting backwards to the right.

2. $\circlearrowright \rightarrow$ sR, Lxb, sR, Lxf. x 2
