

KEY TO NOTATION

⊖ = Direction that nose faces

→ = Direction of movement

(Directions are given in words for some diagonals, curves, etc., if my PC doesn't have the appropriate symbols)

b = behind br. = brush

cl. = close f = in front

L.o.D. = line of dance sim. = similarly

q = quick R slip-step = R q, L q, R.

s = side (steps) or slow (rhythm), e.g. sR s = sidestep right (slow)

x = cross (steps) x 2 = twice

(...) x 3 = do steps within brackets 3 times.

Commas are used solely to separate the steps. Semicolons are sometimes used instead of commas to separate sections, or bars, of the dance.
