

WISE MAID

Chor.; Paul Boizot, 1994 approx. Music; Wise Maid, trad. Irish by Kangaroo Moon, from "Bagpipes On The Beach" (CD available via www.kangaroomoon.com). The tune is alternatively known as "All Around The World (For Sport)"! This version has been edited to fade out; on the original, it runs straight into a song ("Danny's Song") to which the steps also fit.

Arms; V. Long intro, start with the tune.

↷← Rxf *, sL, Rxb, sL, Rxf *, small bounce on R, ↷ rock back onto ball of L (keep steps **very small** to this point), swing R round in wide arc clockwise pointing toe; ↷→ R, br. L, L, swivel anticlockwise 90° on L with a very small bounce; facing & moving slightly diag. to left of centre step R *, small bounce on R, rock back on L, small bounce on L.

Let arms swing in lightly a little on steps marked *. The grapevine steps are very small, and the swing round as large as you can make it without kicking the person on your right, and the following three steps to the right medium, so the circle should gradually travel anti-clockwise, or at least stay in the same place.
